

I [ I am submitting a recommendation that the Yucca mountain nuclear waste site be terminated for a number of reasons:

1. Establishing a large dump site for nuclear waste encourages the continued production of new nuclear waste and the building of more nuclear plants which can in turn use off plant – out of state - Yucca mountain depository to dump more waste.
2. The use of nuclear power should be extremely limited, not encouraged, as it does not degrade in a short time, and can cause devastating effects on the environment.
3. There is no guarantee that Yucca or any depository can prevent the leakage of nuclear waste over time. A huge depository close to a large population of people does not make sense.
4. Nevada has already had more than it's share of nuclear testing, and nuclear dumping. I don't hear any other states stepping up to volunteer to be a nuclear waste dump site even though other states depend heavily on nuclear waste.
5. Transporting nuclear waste across the country is simply crazy. If this country is so worried about terrorism, think of the damage that could be done by attempting to transport (on a regular basis) nuclear waste. ]
